To apply for this program you must:

- Be currently receiving or have received Employment Insurance benefits in the past 60 months
- Be referred by a WorkBC Case Manager
- Be 19 years of age or older
- Have a minimum English CLB Level 6 or 7 (be prepared to show this)
- Complete a pre-screening interview and demonstrate program suitability
- Be able to travel to/from all training locations AND be available to train days, early mornings, evenings, weekends and holidays including long weekends.

Applicants must also meet the following requirements prior to final selection:

- Have a full-privilege B.C. Class 5 Driver's licence or out-of-province equivalent
- Provide a current Driving Record (less than 4 penalty point incidents in the past 2 years plus no driving-related criminal convictions in the past 3 years)
- Obtain a clean Criminal Record Check
- No outstanding fines, debts, or fees owed to ICBC
- Complete an ICBC physician approved Driver's Medical Examination

Applicants must be referred by a WorkBC Case Manager.
