

ICBC Road Test Details and Fees

1. Arrival

- On your Road Test day, ICBC requires you to **arrive at the Driver Licensing Office 15 Minutes before your scheduled test time** for check in.

2. 2 pieces of ID & Other Documents

- At least 1 piece must be primary: BCID, BC Driver's License, BC Services Card (with photo) Birth Certificate, Canadian passport and
- 1 piece may be secondary: BC Care Card, School ID, Bank/Credit Card, Foreign Passport, Nexus Card
- GLP Documents (Certificate of Completion)
- Corrective Lenses (Restriction 21)

3. Outstanding Fees

- All outstanding bridge tolls, tickets, transit violations and ICBC fees **must be paid prior to your road test date** or you may not be able to test.

4. Road Test Fees

Class 5 Retest	Free	Initiated by RoadSafety BC
Code 7 House Trailer Endorsement	\$50	Recreational Vehicle (RV)

Class 6	\$50	Full Privilege Motorcycle License
Class 8	\$35	For riders in the GLP Stages (L&N)

If your Commercial, passenger or motorcycle road test is unsuccessful, re-test wait times apply. Visit www.icbc.com for more details.

5. Licensing Fees

- \$17 if your Driver's License expires over 6 months from your test date
- \$75 if your Driver's License expires in less than 6 months from your test date.

ICBC Road Test and licensing fees can be paid by: cash, debit, cheque or credit

6. Medical Forms:

- Commercial Drivers (Classes 1-4) need to purchase a \$28 ICBC Medical Form. This form must be completed by a Doctor and submitted to ICBC within 45 days of a successful Road Test. Doctors may charge additional fees to complete the form.

7. Cancellation

- ICBC **requires 48 Hours notice for all Road Test cancellations** in order to avoid a cancellation fee.
