Your opportunity to acquire a Class 1 license (which allows you to drive not only semi-trailer trucks, but vehicles requiring a Class 2, 3 or 4 license, too) as well as the training needed to kickstart your career in transportation.

You are eligible to participate if you are an unemployed woman who:

- Is currently on EI or have been within the last five years OR;
- Has earned \$2,000 or more and paid employee EI premiums in at least 5 of the last 10 years OR;
- Has established a benefit period and was paid maternity benefits within the past five years and are re-entering the labour force
- Has a valid Class 5 BC driver's licence and an acceptable driver's abstract
- Is proficient in English
- Is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident

**All eligible participants require a referral from a WorkBC Centre.
